

Stewart Diagnosed With Cancer

Bedford Township Supervisor Greg Stewart has announced he was diagnosed with prostate cancer recently.

Mr. Stewart underwent surgery to remove his prostate and was released from the hospital. He later developed a blood clot “which is common” with the procedure, he said, and was readmitted.

He has been on medical leave for several weeks, but said he has been working from the hospital by conducting conference calls and doing other paperwork.

“I’m feeling pretty good and the doctor thinks I could be back to work (soon)” Mr. Stewart said. “I plan on attending Relay for Life — I get a different T-shirt this year which is pretty cool.”
